Hazard associated with Activity:

Transmission of Coronavirus Covid-19

Who is at risk?

1. Tour guide (Adam Sargant)
2. Attendees

Potential severity of harm:

Covid-19 has a risk of death estimated between 1% and approx 3.5%

Non-fatal cases have long term consequences as yet not fully understood ("long covid")

Pre-existing mitigating factors

All Ghost Tours take place outdoors

Control measures

1. All tours groups to consist of single families/bubbles
2. Tour group max size to be 5 (max size inc guide is 6)
3. Guide to wear mask at all times
4. Guide to remain 2m from attendees where ever possible
4. Attendees to be advised to wear masks at all times (with regard to exemptions)
5. Contact details to be taken for all attendees (or responsible adults in the case of minors)


Circumstances requiring action

1. Suspicion of, or diagnosis of, Covid-19 in tour guide
2. Reporting of suspicion of, or diagnosis of, Covid-19 in any attendee

Actions to be taken

In all cases: All future tours to be cancelled for the next 14 days and, if tour guide shows symptoms, until tour guide has self-isolated in lines with NHS guidelines. Attendee contact details to be passed to NHS Tract and Trace.
